### NORMAN, OK


Norman is located 20 miles south of downtown Oklahoma City and is part of the Oklahoma City metropolitan area. Economically, the city has prominent higher education and related research industries, as it is home to the University of Oklahoma, the largest university in the state, with nearly 32,000 students enrolled. The university is well known for its sporting events with over 85,000 people routinely attending football games. The university is home to several museums, including the Fred Jones Jr. Museum of Art, which contains the largest collection of French Impressionist art ever given to an American university, as well as the Sam Noble Museum of Natural History. The National Weather Center, located in Norman, houses a unique collection of university, state, federal, and private sector organizations working together to improve understanding of events related to the atmosphere.




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## **LEGACY PARK**

throughout the year.












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
### **LEGACY TRAIL**

Legacy Trail is a 4-mile long, paved pathway, that spans between Legacy Park (located here in the UTC development) and the University of Oklahoma campus. The trail follows alongside 24th Ave. NW, W. Robinson St., James Garner Ave., and W. Duffy St. The trail begins at Legacy Park, wraps around the airport, goes past the Westwood Park golf course, and passes Andrews Park, ending up at the University of Oklahoma. Future extention of the trail is planned to the north of the UTC development.
























